

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NEW HAVEN BOARD OF ALDERS
AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NEW HAVEN (MAYOR OR
CONTROLLER) TO ENTER INTO A FOUR-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH
SHOTSPOTTER INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE-MILLION, SIX
HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX THOUSAND, NINE-HUNDRED AND
NINETEEN DOLLARS (\$1,676,919) TO EXPAND AND PROVIDE
GUNFIRE DETECTION SYSTEM/SOFTWARE.**

WHEREAS, Section 2-376 (A) of the Code of General Ordinances, “Unless expressly authorized by law or by vote of the board of aldermen, the city shall not be bound by any contract executed after one (1) year from the date thereof. The board of aldermen's prior approval is necessary for any city contract that does not go to bid that costs more than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00)”; and

WHEREAS, The City of New Haven submitted a proposal using the American Rescue Plan Act to expand the coverage area of ShotSpotter; and,

WHEREAS, The City is seeking approval to enter into a four-year agreement with an estimated timeframe of January 01, 2022 to December 31, 2025 depending on Board of Alder Approval; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the **New Haven Board of Alders** that the City Mayor or Controller be authorized to enter into a four-year agreement, effective January 1, 2022 with ShotSpotter Inc., for a total cost of \$1,676,919.
