

## **Hamden Art League Winter Exhibition Prospectus**

November 26, 2025 – January 6, 2026 Miller Library Senior Center, 2901 Dixwell Ave., Hamden

Eligibility: Paid-up HAL members, two entries allowed at \$12 each, including PayPal fee.

Non-members, two entries allowed at \$22 each, including PayPal fee.

**Medium:** Oils, acrylics, graphics, watercolors, pastels, collage, printmaking (handprinted, etching,

Monotype, lithography, etc.), mixed media, fabric art and wall-hung relief art (not to exceed 3" protrusion and 20 lbs.). NO photography, giclee, computer art, crafts or free-standing sculpture. Artwork previously exhibited at a regular HAL exhibit is not

eligible, but artwork that was in a HAL plein air online exhibit is eligible.

**Participation:** Entries must be submitted electronically through the Hamden Art League website by

midnight, Sunday, November 23rd. Submission of an image of artwork is *required*. See website for further information (https://www.hamdenartleague.org/exhibitions.html)

**Receiving:** Tuesday, November 25th, 4:30—6:30 pm in Social Hall. *Please do not arrive before* 

4:30 pm for receiving, at start of exhibit and also for pickups at the end of the exhibit.

Do not park in the circle near the door.

Rules: Works must be ORIGINAL and not previously shown at a HAL exhibit. No

copies of paintings. ALL entries must have screw eyes and be securely wired. NO saw tooth hangers or brackets. Works not to exceed 36" in width, including frame. NO diptychs or triptychs. Exhibit Committee will try to hang all entries, but is responsible for final decisions. Artwork must be appropriate for all audiences and age groups. HAL reserves the right to reject any piece it considers inappropriate.

Reception/Awards: Tuesday, December 9th, 7-9 pm

Miller Library Senior Center. Store/restaurant packaged refreshments are welcome.

Removal of artwork: Tuesday, January 6th, 4:30-6:30 pm, no removal prior to that date/time.

other arrangements.

Gallery Hours: In accordance with Library Senior Center schedule: 8:30 am-4:30 pm weekdays.

Sales: Price or NFS accepted. HAL requests that the artist of a sold painting donate 20

percent of the selling price to HAL. All work must remain in show until removal

date.
